

“Galaxy Funder”

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Description:

Galaxy Funder is a **WooCommerce Crowdfunding System Plugin**. It Supports **Back End Campaign Creations for Admin** and **Front End Campaign Submission for Users**. With **Galaxy Funder**, you can run a **Full Fledged Crowdfunding Site** or add campaigns for Crowdfunding on top of your **Existing WooCommerce Shop**. All Payments are handled by WooCommerce. Galaxy Funder doesn't do anything related to payment handling of the WooCommerce plugin.

Two types of Crowdfunding Campaigns are supported i.e **Fundraising by Crowdfunding** and **Product Purchase by Crowdfunding**. **Fundraising by Crowdfunding** is the Regular type of running a **Crowdfunding Campaign for Raising Funds**. **Product Purchase by Crowdfunding** can be used if a buyer wants to **Buy a Product** from your WooCommerce shop by **Raising Funds through Crowdfunding**.

Galaxy Funder is a **Very Comprehensive Crowdfunding Plugin** and you might have to read the documentation a few times and play with the plugin for some time to get a good hold of the Plugin's **Working** and **Functionalities**.

Getting Started With Galaxy Funder:

How to Install:

There are two ways to install the Plugin. One is the Automatic Installation and another is the Manual Installation.

Automatic Installation:

- Unzip the “galaxyfunder.zip” you will find a document folder and a Compressed “gf.zip” file . The document folder contains the documentation for your reference. And “gf.zip” is the actual plugin.
- Automatic Installation is the easiest option as WordPress handles the file transfers and you don’t even have to leave your web browser. To do an automatic install of **Galaxy Funder**, log in to your WordPress admin panel and go to: **Plugins -> Add New**.
- In the “**Upload**” field browse Plugin zip folder “gf.zip” and click upload. You can install it by simply clicking Install Now. After clicking that link you will be asked to **Activate Plugin or Return to Plugins Page**. Click Activate Plugin and the installation will automatically complete.

Manual Installation:

- Unzip the Compressed “galaxyfunder.zip” file, you will find a document folder and a compressed “gf.zip” file. The document folder contains the documentation for your reference. And “gf.zip” is the actual plugin.

- Using an FTP program or your hosting control panel, upload the unzipped Plugin folder to your WordPress installation's **wp-content/plugins** directory.
- The Plugin works once you click "**Activate**" from the Plugins Menu

Go to **WooCommerce -> Galaxy Funder**

How to Upgrade to a newer version of Galaxy Funder?

If you are using an older version and want to upgrade to the latest version of Galaxy Funder then please do the following steps.

1. Deactivate and Delete the existing version of Galaxy Funder in your site.
2. Download the latest version file (galaxyfunder.zip) of Galaxy Funder.
3. Unzip "galaxyfunder.zip" inside which you will find the Plugins files i.e. "gf.zip"
4. Install the latest version of Galaxy Funder i.e. "gf.zip" using WordPress Dashboard.
5. Activate the Plugin.

Note: You will not lose any settings values, data etc by following the above steps.

Support

Work Flow of Galaxy Funder:

- Campaign Creation by Admin
- Campaign Submission by User
- Manual Contribution for Campaign by Admin
- Add Perk rule for the Campaign
- Campaign Extension
- Mail Notifications
- Shortcode Generator for Campaign
- Contribution Table for Campaign

Campaign Creation by Admin

- The Admin creates a Campaign at the back-end and Publish it for User's Contribution.
- Once the Campaign reached it's End Method it will be closed.

Campaign Submission by User:

- The User Creates a Campaign at the Front-End using Frontend Submission form.
- The submitted form will be available for admin's approval. If the admin approve the Campaign, then it will be Published for Contribution.
- When the Campaign reached it's End Method, based on the Crowdfunding Type the Campaign Creator will get their Fund or Product.

Manual Contribution for Campaign by Admin:

- The Admin can Contribute manually for the Campaigns.
- It helps the Campaigns to get more popular among the funders.

Add Perk rule for the Campaign:

- Funders can Contribute for the Campaigns using Perk rule.
- If Admin Creates the Perks using Products, then Funders will get the Products as a compliment for Funding the Campaign using Perks.
- Multiple Perks can be created for a Campaign.

Campaign Extension:

- Using Campaign Extension Form the Users can request the admin to Extend their Campaign. The Link for Extending Campaign will be displayed in User's My Campaigns table.
- Once the Form is Submitted it will be available for Admin's Approval.
- If the Admin approve the Request then the Campaign will be extended else it will be closed.

Mail Notifications:

- Mail notifications are available for Submission, Approval, Rejection, Deletion, Contribution and Completion of the Campaign.
- Notifications can be send to the Admin as well as the Campaign Creators.
- Mail contents can be customized using Mail Templates.

Shortcode Generator for Campaign:

- Shortcodes can be generated for Campaigns to show it anywhere in Page, Post, sidebar, etc.

- Each Campaign has a Separate shortcode.

Contribution Table for Campaign:

- Contribution details of the Campaign will be displayed using the Contribution Table.
- Contribution Table contains the Contributor's details, Contribution amount and Perk details.
- For each Campaigns, the table will be displayed in the Single Product Page which will help the Funders to see the previous contributions by other funders for the Campaign.

Setting Up Galaxy Funder:

How to Create a Crowdfunding Campaign?

Create a New Product or Edit an Existing Product under **Product Settings**

- Enter the Regular Price.
- Select the **Enable Galaxy Funder** check-box.
- Select **Fundraising by CrowdFunding** or **Product Purchase by CrowdFunding** option from **CrowdFunding Type** drop-down menu.
- If **Fundraising by Crowdfunding** Type is Selected, then set values in the following fields.
 - If you want to set Minimum Price for the Campaign Contribution, then set the Minimum value in **Minimum Price** field.
 - If you don't want to display the Minimum price, then Enable the **Hide Minimum Price** checkbox.
 - Enter the Price to be displayed in the Contribution field in **Recommended Price** field.
 - If you want to set maximum values for the Contribution, then set the Maximum value in the **Maximum Contribution** field.
 - If you don't want to display the Maximum price, then Enable the **Hide Maximum Contribution** checkbox.
 - Enter the Goal amount of the Campaign in the **Target Price** field.
 - If you wish to Hide the Target Price, then select **Hide Target Price** check-box.
- If **Product Purchased by CrowdFunding** Type is Selected, then select the Products to be Purchased by Crowdfunding in **Choose Product** Search box.
 - The Product Price will be added as Goal amount in the **Target Price** text field.
 - If you want to use the Product Image as the Campaign Image, then Enable **Use Selected Product Featured Image** check-box.

- If you want to Hide the Target price, then select the **Hide Target Price** check-box.
- Select the End Method from **Campaign End Method** drop-down menu.
 - If **Target Goal** is selected, then the Campaign will be Closed once the Goal amount is Reached.
 - If **Target Date** is selected, then **From Date** and **To Date** fields will be displayed. In the respective fields you need to select the Starting Date and Ending date as well as set the Hour and Minutes. Once the Campaign reaches the date set in **To Date**, the Campaign will be closed.
 - If **Target Goal and Target Date** is Selected, then the Campaign will be closed when both the **Target Goal** and **Target Date** is Reached.
 - If **Campaign Never Ends** is selected, then the Campaign will not be ended.
- Select the **Enable Social Promotion** check-box to promote the Campaign through Social Media such as Facebook Like, Twitter tweet and Sharing the Campaign through Google+.
 - If you want Facebook promotion for the Campaign then select the **Enable Social Promotion Through Facebook** check-box.
 - If you like to promote the Campaign through Twitter, then Select the **Enable Social Promotion Through Twitter** check-box.
 - The Promotion through Google+ can be done by selecting the **Enable Social Promotion Through Google+** check-box
- If you want to display the Contributor Table in front-end, then Select **Enable Show Contributor Table** check-box.
- Select the **Enable Mark Contributors as Anonymous** to display the Contributors as Anonymous in the Contribution Table of the Campaign.
- Enter the PayPal Id of the Campaign Creator in the **Campaigner PayPal ID** field to receive the Contribution amount directly to the Campaign Creator's PayPal account.
- Choose the Styles for displaying the price in different styles from **Select Style** menu.
 - If **Editable Textbox** is selected, then textbox which can be edited by the Funder's will be displayed.
 - If **Non-Editable Textbox** is selected, then Recommended price will be set as the default Contribution amount which can't be edited by the Funder's.
 - If **Predefined Buttons** is selected, then 6 Amount fields will be displayed. In the fields you can set different amount for Contribution. The amount set in the fields will be displayed in button format in the Campaign page so that the Funders can Contribute by clicking the respective buttons.
 - If **Predefined List** is selected, then the amount set in the fields will be displayed in

drop down menu so that Funders can select the Contribution amount from the menu.

- Publish or Update the Campaign.

How to Set Crowdfunding Campaign Submission?

Create a New Page and Enter the Shortcode [**crowd_fund_form**] in the description part and Publish the Page to enable the Crowdfunding Submission Form.

Go to **WooCommerce -> Galaxy Funder -> Frontend Submission**

- Select the submission method from **Front End Submission Method** drop-down menu.
 - If **Goes For Moderation** method is selected, then once the Frontend Campaign Submission form is submitted, it will be available for Admin's approval.
 - If **Goes Live** method is selected, then the Campaign will be published instantly without waiting for Admin's approval.
- By default, once the Guest tries to Submit the form it will redirect to Login Page. If you wish to Customize it, then enter the redirection URL for Guest in **URL to Redirect for Guest** field
- When the User Submits the form, by default it will not redirect to any page. If you wish to Redirect the user to another page, then select the **Enable** option in **Enable URL Redirect after Campaign is Submitted** option.
- If **Enable** is chosen, then the Redirection URL need to be mentioned in the **URL to Redirect after Campaign Submission** Field. If left empty, then it will not Redirect to any Page.
- By default, both the Crowdfunding types will displayed in Frontend Submission form. If you want to Show only a single Crowdfunding type, then select the **Hide** option in **Display Crowdfunding Type** so that the selected funding type in **Crowdfunding Type** option only will be displayed in Frontend Submission form.
- If **All Products** is selected in **Products for Crowdfunding Campaign**, then the User can select a Product from the available list for Product purchased by Crowdfunding.
- If you want to provide the Users only particular products for the Crowdfunding, then set **Selected Products** in **Products for Crowdfunding Campaign** and select the Products in **Select Particular Products** search field.
- If **All Categories** option is selected in Categories for crowdfunding Campaign, then all the available categories will be displayed for the Campaign.
- If you want to provide the Users only selected Categories, then set **Selected Categories** in the **Categories for crowdfunding Campaign** and select the Categories in **Categories for Front End Submission** field.

- Select **Show/Hide** from **Display Campaign End Method in Frontend Submission Form** option to Show/Hide the Campaign end method in the form.
- By default, Recommended Contribution, Maximum Contribution and Minimum Contribution fields will be displayed in the form. If you wish to Hide these fields, then Enable the **Hide Recommended Contribution, Hide Maximum Contribution, Hide Minimum Contribution** check-boxes respectively.
- By default, Perk Rule button will be displayed in the form so that Users can create Perks in frontend. If you don't want to provide that option in the form, then choose **Hide** in **Display Add Perk Rule Button in Frontend Submission form** option.
- If you want to Limit the Campaign Submission for a single User, then Enable **Limit Number of Campaigns per User** check-box and enter the limit count in **Number of campaigns to be allowed per User** field.

How Manually add Contribution for Campaign?

Creating Custom Contribution for the campaigns is easy without making Payment. Follow the below steps to Contribute manually

Goto **WooCommerce → Orders → Add Order**

- If you want to associate the Contribution to an Existing User, then search Customer Name in **Customer** search-box and select the customer or else left empty.
- Then, in **Order Items** Meta Box, click **Add Products** button so that a Search Box will be displayed. In that box, search the Campaign you wish to contribute manually and click **Add** button.
- After adding the Campaign you can see **Pen** tool in **Total** column. Click the pen tool so that the **Total** can be editable. You can now edit the total as your wish based on your contribution and Click **Save** button. Now, click the **Calculate Total** button. Finally change the **Order Status** to **Completed** and click **Save Order**.
- You are done with the Manual Contribution.

How to get a Product by Creating a Crowdfunding Campaign?

The User can create a Crowdfunding Campaign to buy a Product using Frontend Submission Form.

- In Crowdfunding Submission form, select the **Product Purchased by CrowdFunding** in **Crowdfunding Type** drop-down menu.
- Enter the Title for the Campaign in the **Campaign Title** field.
- Select the End method from **Campaign End Method** drop-down menu and choose the Products from **Choose Products** search-field.
- If you want to use the Product image as Campaign Image, then Enable **Use Selected**

Product Featured image check-box or else if you wish to add a new image to the Campaign, then click the **Browse** button and select the Image in **Featured Image** option.

- If **Target Goal** is selected as **Campaign End Method**, then Regular/Sale Price of the selected product will be automatically set as **Goal** amount which is non editable.
- If **Target Date** is selected as **Campaign End Method**, then enter the number of days in **Campaign Duration in Days** field.
- If you want to Add Perk to the Campaign then Click **Add Perk Rule** Button.
- Enter the Billing and Shipping Credentials in the respective fields.
- If the Billing and Shipping Credentials are same, then Enable **Same as Billing Information** check-box.
- If you want to enable Social Promotion for the Campaign, then select the **Enable Social Promotion for this Campaign** check-box.
- Search and select a Category for the Campaign in **Choose Category** search-field.
- If you want to display the Contributor's details for the Campaign, then Enable **Show Contributor Table for this Campaign** check-box.
- If you have PayPal Id then Enter it in the **PayPal Id** Field.
- Enable the **I Agree** Check-box.
- Submit the Campaign using **Submit** Button.

How to Add Perk settings for the Campaign?

Go to **WooCommerce -> Galaxy Funder -> Single Product Page - > Perk Table Settings**

- Select **Show** option in **Perk Table Show/Hide** drop-down menu.
- Select **Perk Name** or **Perk Product** option in **Perk Url Type** drop-down menu.
 - If **Perk Name** is selected, then the Perk will be displayed with it's Name.
 - If **Perk Product** is Selected, then **Perk Product Image Display Section** and **Perk Product Image Display Size** will be displayed.
- Choose **Perk Product Name** or **Perk Product Image** or **Perk Product Image and Name** radio-button in **Perk Product Image Display Section** option.
 - If Perk Product Name is selected, then it only displays the Name of the product.
 - If Perk Product Image is selected, then it only displays the Image of the product.
 - If Perk Product Image and Name is selected, then it displays both Name and Image of the product.
- Customize the size of Product Image in **Perk Product Image Display Size** field.

- Select the Position of the Perk Table in **Perk Table Position** selection.
 - If **Before Single Product** is selected, then it will be displayed above the product.
 - If **After Single Product** is selected, then it will be displayed at the end of the product.
 - If **After Single Product Summary** is selected, then it will be displayed below the product and above the description of the product.
- Select Single Selection or Multiple Selection radio-button in Perk Selection Type option.
 - If **Single Selection** is selected, then Funder can select only a single Perk at a time.
 - If **Multiple Selection** is selected, then Funder can select multiple Perks at a time.
- By default, a user can select the quantity of a Perk. If you don't wish to allow Users to choose the quantity of a Perk, then select Disable in **Perk Quantity Selection** option.
- Select the **Top Left** or **Top Right** or **Bottom Left** or **Bottom Right** options in **Perk Quantity Display Position** option to display the Perk Quantity Selection in the respective positions.

How to Enable Campaign Extension Request?

Create a Page and Paste the Short code [**crowd_fund_extension**] in the Page Content. Note the Page Id(Post ID).

Go to **WooCommerce -> Galaxy Funder -> My Account Page**

- Enter the Page Id of created page in **Page Id of Contribution Extension Link** field.
- After making these changes, the **Extension Link** will be displayed in the Campaign Table.
- Once the **Link** has been clicked, you will be redirected to a form where the user can find Campaign Extension Request form.
- Select the **New Campaign End Method** and **New Campaign Target Amount**.
- When the User submits the form, Campaign Extension Request will be send to the Site Admin for approval and if the Admin approves the request, then the New Campaign End Method and New Campaign Target Amount will be Updated.
- The Extension Request made by the User will be available for Admin approval in the **Campaign Extension Request** tab.

How to Edit the Mail Notification Templates?

Goto **WooCommerce -> Galaxy Funder -> Mail**

- Enable the Send Mail on Campaign Submission check-box to send mails when Campaign is submitted. If you select **Send Email on Campaign Submission** option then

Email will be Send when Campaign Submission is made by the User.

- Select the Receivers in the **Send Email to** check-box.
- Customize the Mail Subject in **Campaign Mail Subject** field.
- Customize the Mail Contents in **Campaign Submission Email Message** field.
- Customize the Unsubscribe link message in **Unsubscribe Link Message for Email** text field.

Using the above steps you can Customize the Mail Template for Campaign Approval, Campaign Rejection, Campaign Completion, Campaign Deletion and Campaign Contribution.

How to generate shortcode for a Campagin?

Go to **WooCommerce -> Galaxy Funder -> Shortcode Generator**

- Select the **Enable Title in Shortcode** check-box to display the Campaign Title when using the shortcode.
- Select the **Enable Description in Shortcode** check-box to display the Description of the Campaign when using the shortcode.
- Choose the Campaigns to generate shortcode in **Select Campaigns** search-box.
- The shortcode for the selected Campaign will be displayed in the **Shortcode** Section.
- Use this generated shortcode to show the Campaign anywhere in a Page, Post, Slidebar, etc.
- If you want to Trim the number of words in the Description, then set the number of words to be trimmed in **Enter Number of Words to Trim from Description** field.

How to Customize Contribution Table Settings for the Campaign?

Goto **WooCommerce -> Galaxy Funder -> General -> Contribution Table Settings**

- Select **Show** in **Contribution Table Show/Hide** drop-down menu to display the Contribution Table.
- If you want to display Search Box in Contribution Table, then select **Show** option in **Search Box Show/Hide** drop-down menu.
- If you want to display the Page Size option in Contribution Table then Select **Show** in **Page Size Option Show/Hide**.
- Select **Show** option in **Contributor Image Column Show/Hide** drop-down menu to display the Contributor Image Column in the table.
- To customize the size of the Contributor Image, then set the size(in px) in **Contributor Image Size** field.

- If you want to display the Contributor Name, then select **Show** in **Contributor Column Show/Hide** option.
- If you wish to display the Contributor Email Id, then Select **Show** in **Contributor Email Id Column Show/Hide** option.
- If you wish to display Contribution Column, then select **Show** in **Contribution Column Show/Hide** option. If **Hide** option is selected, then Contribution Column will not be displayed.
- If you want to display the Perk Name Column, then select **Show** in **Perk Name Column Show/Hide** option.
- To display Perk Amount column, then select **Show** in **Perk Amount Column Show/Hide** option.
- If you select **Show** in **Perk Quantity Column Show/Hide** option, then Perk Quantity will be displayed.
- If you wish to display the Date column, then select **Show** in **Date Column Show/Hide option**. Select **Hide** if you don't want to display it.
- Select the Position of the Contributor Table in **Contributor Table Position** selection.
 - If **Before Single Product** is selected, then it will be displayed above the Campaign.
 - If **After Single Product** is selected, then it will be displayed below the Campaign.
 - If **After Single Product Summary** is selected, then it will be displayed below the Campaign and above the Campaign description part.

How to Restrict the Normal Products with Campaign Product in the Cart?

Goto **WooCommerce** → **Galaxy Funder** → **General** -> **Restriction for Cart**

- Select **Enable** option in **Don't Allow Other Products in the Cart when Cart contain Crowdfunding Campaign** drop-down menu.
- Save the Settings.

Language Translation

Galaxy Funder Plugin is Translation ready meaning you can edit the PO files by which you can translate it to any language.

The steps to do the translation are as follows. For eg let us consider translation to French.

1. Download and Install [Poedit](#).
2. Open the file Galaxy Funder → Languages Folder → galaxyfunder-fr_FR.po using [Poedit](#).
3. Choose the Source text and set its Corresponding French text in Translation Text Area.

4. Save the Changes.
5. In wp-config.php define the WPLANG as French. Syntax is define ('WPLANG', 'fr_FR').

Requirements

The Minimum Server requirements and the Wordpress requirements as follows

1. PHP 5.2.4 or Greater
2. MYSQL 5.0 or Greater
3. Wordpress 3.4 or Higher
4. WooCommerce 2.0+

Browser Compatibility

Galaxy Funder works fine with all major browsers such as IE8.0+, Mozilla, Chrome, Safari, Opera etc.

Theme Compatibility

Galaxy Funder works fine with all the Top Themes.

Caution and Troubleshooting:

1.Appearance of the Crowdfunding Campaign in Different Themes

The Appearance of Crowdfunding Campaign depends on the Theme which you are using. There are three **Inbuilt Styles** available for displaying the Crowdfunding Campaign. You can choose any one of those or you can create your own style by selecting the **custom styles** option. Paste your CSS for the classes displayed above in the Inbuilt CSS Column.

2.Layout is Changed Once Galaxy Funder is Activated

By default the layout is loaded from the Template file of WooCommerce. If you face any layout changes after activating the Galaxy Funder plugin goto **WooCommerce → Galaxy Funder → General → Troubleshoot → Load Template**

3. Generate Shortcode for Particular Campaign

If you wish to place information about a particular campaign in any of your page or post you will need a shortcode for displaying the Campaign. Goto **WooCommerce → Galaxy Funder → Shortcode Generator → Select Campaigns**

The Campaigns created will be automatically shown in the drop down menu. You can Select the Campaign you want and the shortcode for that Campaign will be displayed in the

Shortcode Menu.

You can Place the shortcode anywhere you like. When you place this shortcode, it will display the following:

1. Name of the Campaign
2. Target of the Campaign
3. Amount Collected

This act as a hyper-link to the Crowdfunding Campaign. When a contributor clicks on the Hyper-link they will be redirected to the Campaign Page.

4. Campaign Products are not added to the Cart when redirected it shows cart is Empty

This issue is caused mainly by SSL. If you run a domain under HTTPS this problem occurs. To overcome this issue go to

WooCommerce → Galaxy Funder → General → Troubleshoot → Load Ajax From

By default the option will be from Admin URL. If you face a problem in adding products to cart try changing it to Load from Site URL

Frequently Asked Questions

1. I am unable to activate the Galaxy Funder Plugin?

Please make sure WooCommerce Plugin is activate before trying to activate the Galaxy Funder Plugin. Galaxy Funder is a WooCommerce Extension Plugin and needs WooCommerce Plugin to be active.

2. Can I run Crowdfunding Campaigns in my existing WooCommerce shop site?

Yes. That is the idea of this plugin. To run Crowdfunding Campaigns in your existing WooCommerce shop along with your other products.

3. Can Users create their own Campaigns from Front end?

Yes. Users can create their own Campaigns and Submit it for site admin approval.

4. Can Users edit their Campaigns?

No, Users can't edit but admin can.

5. How will the Campaign look on my site?

The Plugin provides the functionality and the look and feel depends on your theme.

6. The Contributions made for the Campaigns are changed immediately or when the target is reached?

It works more like indigogo where the Contributions are changed immediately.

7. Who can create a Crowdfunding Campaign?

In addition to the admin any registered member can create and submit their Crowdfunding Campaign for admin approval.

8. Can I add Perks/Rewards to My Crowdfunding Campaign?

Yes, you can choose to add Perk/Rewards for your Crowdfunding Campaign.

9. Can I translate Galaxy Funder to my Own Language?

Yes. Please check the Language Translation in the Documentation for more details.

10. Can I add a Contribution manually for a campaign?

Yes. Please check the “How to Add Contribution Manually” in the Documentation for more details.

11. Contribution Button is not showing in Single Product Page?

If you leave the Regular Price as Empty then this problem will occur. Make Sure you enter 0 or Some valid value in Regular Price and that should solve this problem.

12. How can I customize style of Single Product Page?

As of now we are supporting three Inbuilt designs which is Minimal, IGG and KS Style.

If you want to override the default designs, then in Single Product Page Tab select the Custom Design option and Paste your Custom CSS.

13. Where I can create the Perk option?

Go to Admin Dashboard → Product → Add Product then scroll down to bottom you can find the Perk Meta box to add Perk rule.

14. Can I select Multiple Perks? For example let say perk 1 as 100\$ and Perk 2 as 200\$.If I select both then 300\$ should be the total contribution.

Yes it is possible. You just enable the option of Enable Multiple Perk Selection in Single

Product Page.

15. Layout are Changed in single product page of Galaxy Funder once the plugin is Activated?

Actually, the Layout is changed because of loading the template file from WooCommerce. Use the option in General Settings of Galaxy Funder scroll down to the Troubleshoot section. By default it loads from plugin. Change to from Theme and see if it helps.

16. Is there is a way to hide the Galaxy Funder Product from Shop Page of WooCommerce?

Yes it is possible. You can Show/Hide the Galaxy Funder Product from Shop Page of WooCommerce. This option is in **Galaxy Funder → General Settings**.

17. Is there is a way to generate Short code of Particular Campaign?

Yes you can create a Shortcode for Particular Product in Shortcode Tab.

18. Campaign Product not added to Cart, once it redirects it says Cart is Empty?

Most likely it is causing by SSL. Check if you use HTTPS Plugin in which case go to Troubleshoot Settings of SSL and Change the option as to Load Ajax from Site URL.
